

Rules for the East Coast Regional Championships

July 16-18, 2010 Harriman, TN

1. Open to any rider who resides in the NRCHA Northeastern or Southeastern Regions or lives East of the Mississippi River.
2. Rider must be a current member in good standing of any NRCHA affiliate in the Northeastern or Southeastern Regions.
3. Rider and horse must show a minimum of 2 times at any affiliate sanctioned show in the NRCHA Northeastern or Southeastern Region to qualify to compete.
4. NRCHA rules will apply unless specifically deleted or altered.
5. All entries must have a current negative coggins.
6. OPEN Division(s) is open to all riders. It is the riders' responsibility to know each division they are eligible to compete in.
7. NON PRO Division(s) is open to any rider who possesses a current NRCHA Non Pro card. It is the responsibility of the rider to know each division they are eligible to compete in.
8. East Coast Regional Championship classes will run concurrent with its respective NRCHA approved class at the ECRCHC.
9. Placings will be based on a (2) two go average. Scores from each go will be combined to determine the placings in each class. To be eligible for prize money and awards each rider must compete in both go rounds.
10. There will be one entry fee per class and division. This payment will be broken into an office charge and payback. However, a cattle charge will be assessed per run.
11. Entries must be postmarked by July 5, 2010.
12. The ECRCHC and the East Coast Regional Championship board of directors reserves the right to amend or alter rules and regulations. All decisions are final.
